

"Hi, Alex," said Wind. "Remember, Alex, I speak adventures language and you can understand me and I you" explained Wind.



Nutty the Squirrel.

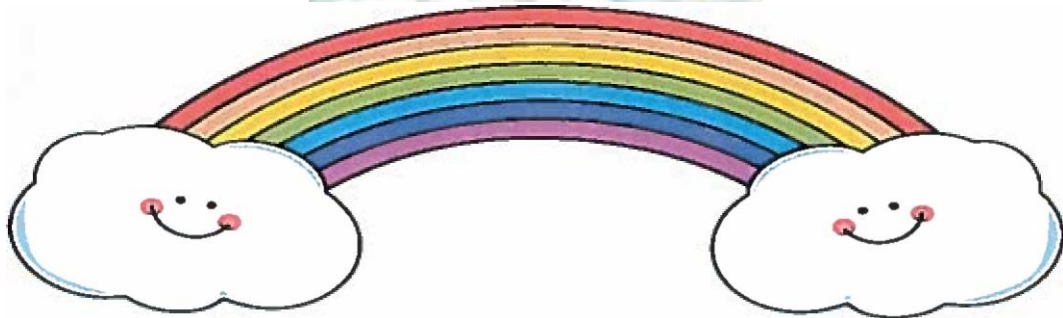
